



Pizza Slice Snugg Sack

Technique:	Sewing, Appliqué, Quilting

Skill Level:	Intermediate
Crafting Time:	Longer term
Finished size:	50" (127cm) long; pillow, 20" (50.80) diameter

Featuring Dual Duty XP®

What child wouldn't love to snuggle into a slice of pizza to watch TV or take a nap? Coupled with the pepperoni pillow, it's pure culinary delight.

Supplies

- Coats Dual Duty XP® All-purpose thread in coordinating colors
- 5½ yd (4.69m) beige print for upper and lower crust, front lining
- 1¾ yd (1.26m) yellow print, for cheese
- ¼ yd (22.86cm) red print, for sauce
- 1¼ yd (1.14m) rust solid (60"), for pillow and pepperoni
- ½ yd (11.43cm) brown print, for mushrooms
- ½ yd (11.43cm) dark green print, for peppers
- 1¾ yd (1.49m) 90" (228.60cm) batting
- 16" (40.64cm) round pillow form)
- Paper-back fusible web
- Walking foot
- Pinking shears (optional)

Cutting

From the beige print, cut:

(3) rectangles, 30" x 54" (76.20cm x 137.16cm), for back crust, back lining, and front lining

(1) strip, 6" x 30" (15.24cm x 76.20cm), for top crust
Enough 2½" (6.35cm) strips to make about 170" (432cm) binding

From the yellow print, cut:

(1) rectangle 30" x 45" (76.20cm x 114.30cm), for cheese

From the red print, cut:

(1) strip, 5¼" x 30" (13.34cm x 76.20cm), for sauce

From the rust solid, cut:

(4) circles, 22" (55.88cm) diameter

(10) circles, 4" (10.16cm) diameter

From the batting, cut:

(3) rectangles, 30" x 54" (76.20cm x 137.16cm)

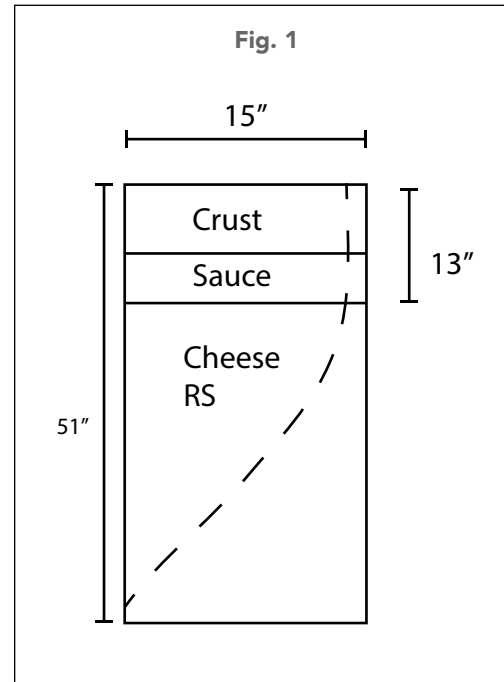
Note: All seam allowances are ¼" (.64cm).

Preparing the Appliqués

- Trace as many mushrooms (pattern on page 3) as desired onto the right side of the folded brown fabric. Stitch around each shape on the drawn line and trim just outside the line. Set aside.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse together the green print fabric wrong sides together. Using pinking shears, cut various sizes of triangles and squares for bell peppers. Set aside.
- To make the pepperoni, sew two rust circles right sides together. Trim ⅛" (.32cm) beyond the stitching line. Make a small slit in one layer of the circle center and turn the pepperoni right side out. Push out the edges and press. Set aside.

Assembling the Upper Slice

- Sew together the cheese rectangle, sauce strip, and upper crust strip. Press seams in one direction.
- Fold the rectangle wrong sides together matching seams and mark the slice shape as shown (Fig. 1).



- Layer the upper slice, a layer of batting, and lining rectangles wrong sides together. Quilt the upper crust and sauce sections as desired. Baste the edges together just inside the drawn lines, and trim the layers along the slice lines.
- Position the pepperoni circles and mushrooms as desired. Edgestitch each piece in place using matching thread.
- To attach the green pepper, make a fold in each piece and pin to the slice as desired. Set the machine for a wide zigzag with zero length. Bartack each pepper piece in place on the fold.

Assembling the Lower Crust

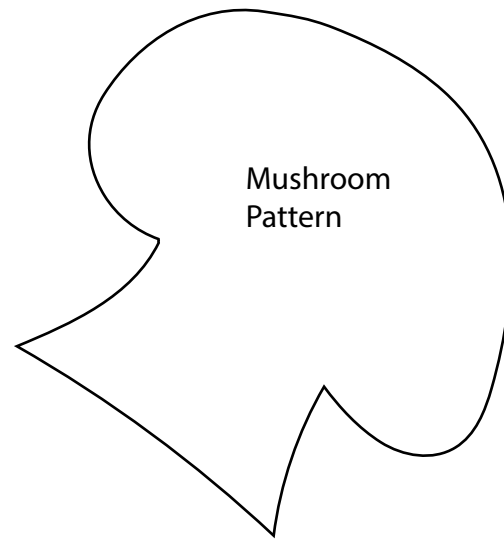
- Layer the two beige rectangles and two batting rectangles wrong sides together. Quilt as desired.
- Lay the upper slice right sides together over the quilted rectangle and trim the lower crust to match the upper slice.

Assembling the Bag

- Sew the layers together along the sides and around the lower tip. Leave the upper edge open.
- Sew together the binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press in half. Bind the bag seams.
- Bind the upper edge of the slice.
- Turn the bag right side out and press.

Assembling the Pillow

- With right sides together, sew two rust circles together around the entire perimeter. Repeat for the second pair.
- Cut a 4" (10.16cm) slit in one layer of the circle center. Turn the circle right side out and press the edges. Topstitch around the perimeter. Repeat for the second circle.
- Layer the circles with the slit sides together and pin around the edges. Center and draw a 16" (40.64cm) diameter circle. Stitch around the inner circle through all layers, leaving about a 12" (30.48cm) opening.
- Stuff the pillow form into the opening and smooth in place. Pin the circles together and continue stitching on the drawn line. Lean on the pillow form to flatten it to make machine stitching easier.
