



Fall Foliage Napkin Rings

Add a touch of fall color to your table setting. These beautiful fall leaves stitched with Coats multi-color thread will make each place setting special.

Finished Size: 4" (10cm)

Supplies

Dual Duty XP multi-color, Fall Leaves 9377 or Autumn 9386
 Cotton print fabrics in fall colors
 Heat Moldable stabilizer
 ½" (1.3cm) Pom poms, 3 per ring
 Pony tail elastic, 1 per ring

Additional Requirements

Iron & Ironing Board
 Sewing Machine
 Basic Sewing Supplies

Instructions

Note: Print and cut out leaf pattern.

1. Trace the leaf pattern as many times as needed onto the feature fabric, allowing two leaves per place setting.
2. Layer with the stabilizer underneath and another fabric below, wrong sides together. Top and bottom fabrics may be the same or different prints.
3. Thread machine on top and bobbin with multi-color thread. Straight stitch around the shape, trim close to the stitching, then satin stitch over the edge pivoting carefully at points. Sew around again if needed for full coverage.
4. Use straight stitching to create veins and stem detail.
5. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for heat molding, using either an iron or a heat gun and shaping the leaf while pliable.
6. When the leaves are cool, stitch two to an elastic pony tail holder and add three small pompoms in the center.
